Proposed changes to the Platform include:

- City-specific priorities related to behavioral and mental health, housing and homelessness, power transmission, recreational opportunities and the Santa Ana River.
- State priorities that emphasize the City’s core values and advance the Cross-Cutting Threads of Community Trust, Equity, Fiscal Responsibility, Innovation, and Sustainability & Resiliency.
- Federal priorities that enhance the ability of local elected officials to respond to the needs of their constituents.
- Positions and Policy Statements categorized under the umbrella of the City Council’s six strategic priority areas of arts, culture and recreation, community well-being, economic opportunity, environmental stewardship, high performing government, and infrastructure, mobility and connectivity.

The Platform further describes additional legislative issues and funding priorities. The City may support legislation that is consistent with the Platform and may oppose legislation that is inconsistent with the Platform. Legislative matters will be reviewed and considered by the City Manager’s Office and position letters will be coordinated with the Mayor’s Office for signature as appropriate.

STRATEGIC PLAN ALIGNMENT:

The City’s Legislative Platform contributes to the six Strategic Priorities in the Envision Riverside 2025 Strategic Plan and aligns with each of the five Cross Cutting Threads.
