CHARTER OFFICERS AND EXECUTIVE UNIT POSITIONS' COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

Human Resources Director Holloman presented a report on the compensation and benefits for Charter Officers and Executive Unit positions. Following discussion, motion was made by Member Soubirous and seconded by Vice Chair Conder to forward to the City Council the recommendation that the City Manager's total combined package be \$274,000 or less, comparable to the State of California Governor. Motion carried unanimously.


Jason Hunter spoke regarding employee compensation and the Budget Engagement Commission.
