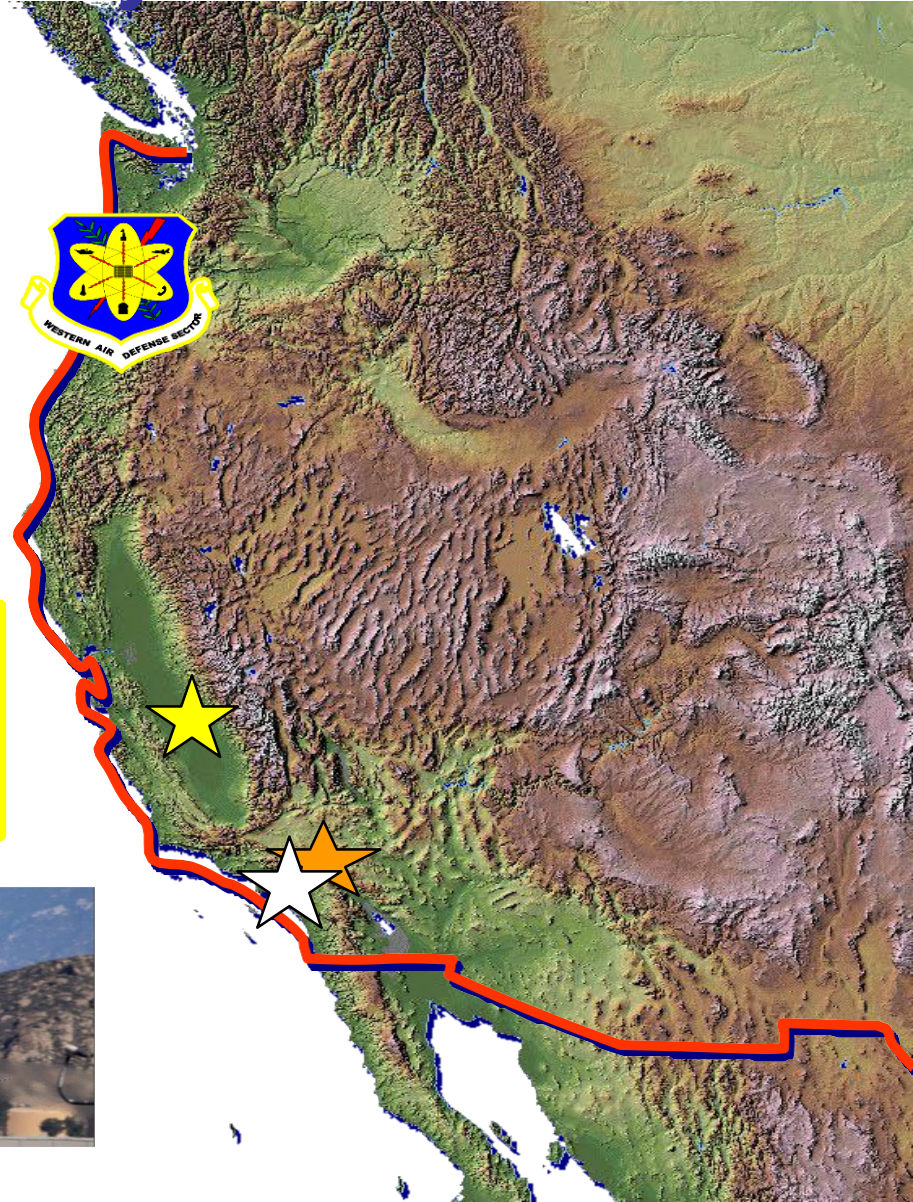
Counterdrug and Border Patrol



Civil Air Patrol's new infrared sensor, attached to the bottom of a Cessna 182, has thermal imaging and video capabilities that are ideal for CAP's search and rescue as well as CD/border patrol missions. The equipment, which has day and night capabilities, was used very effectively during CAP's response to heavy flooding in the NorCal last year.

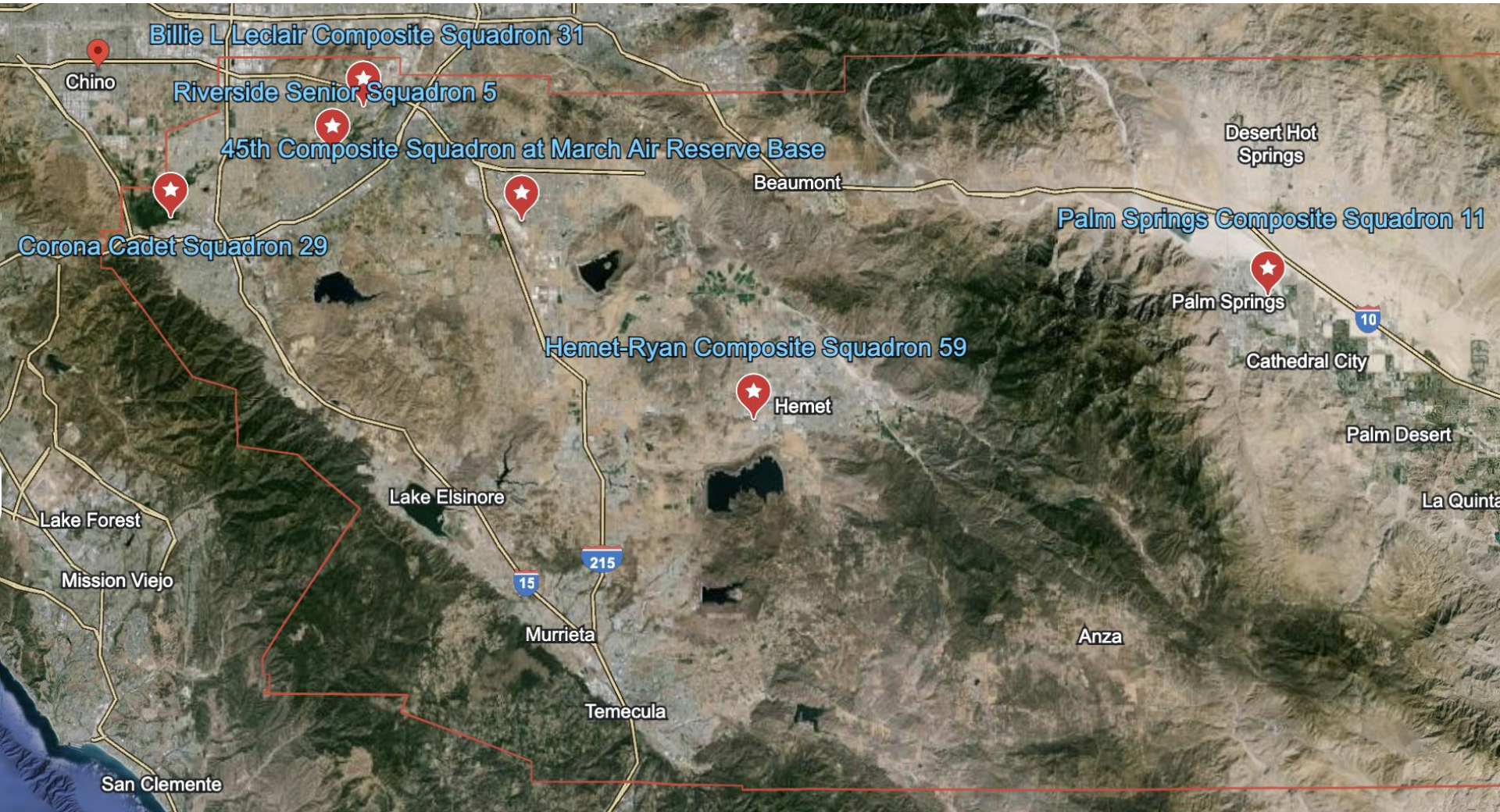

What does Squadron 5 do for the KRAL community?



- Our volunteers stand at the ready to provide SAR base/flight operations for missing aircraft, missing hikers, and lost person's.
- We routinely fly Counter Drug for ICE/CBP, and State Disaster Relief Missions for FEMA/Cal Fire.
- The most important community mission is the support of CAP Cadet, High School AFJROTC Cadet, and College AFROTC Cadet squadrons via Orientation Flights.
- For the months of March - May, we have plans to provide Orientation Flights to nearly 50 Cadets from the following Detachments; CSUSB, Yucaipa HS, Santiago HS, Victor Valley HS, March CAP Cadets, Flabob CAP Cadets, Hemet CAP Cadets.



What economical value CAP brings?

- Our 30+ members utilize almost every Vendor at Riverside in one way or another from the Café, Fuel Vendors, to the Maintenance and repair facilities.
- We also help Airport staff by locating ELT's that are routinely set off accidentally in local Aircraft which saves Airport staff many man hours and frustration.
- Finally, CAP has designated KRAL as the Southern California Consolidated Maintenance location, meaning we send all of our Southern Cal Aircraft to KRAL for maintenance.
