# **LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

Senate Bill (SB) 998 was adopted September 28, 2018 The bill prohibits residential water service from being disconnected under special circumstances.

- 1. Applies to low income residential water customers
- 2. 60 day period during delinquency
- 3. Qualify for amortized payment plans
- 4. Same day connection fee of \$50

### **BACKGROUND**

- 1. Water Rule 7 Discontinuance and Restoration of water Service
  - A. Provides rules for discontinuance of water service
    - i. At the customers request
    - ii. For unsafe equipment
    - iii. Without the application of service
    - iv. Dangerous to the health of the customer
    - v. Inability to pay utility bill
    - vi. Due to fraud
    - vii. Landlord-tenant relationship
    - viii. Master metered

## **DISCUSSION**

#### 1. Proposed Changes to Water Rule 7

- a. As part of the Water Shut-off Protection Act, RPU is required to have a separate discontinuance and restoration of water service for low-income customers
- Documentation requirements for any residential customer who demonstrates a household income below 200% of the Federal poverty level. The requirement is aligned with Riverside Public Utilities' SHARE utility assistance program
- c. Rules for an amortized payment arrangement

#### 2. Proposed Changes to Appendix A

a. \$50 Same day service reconnection charge for low-income customers

## **BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES**
