SCOPE OF SERVICES & COMPENSATION


To provide landscape and general outside maintenance services for the Victoria Avenue parkways and medians within the City of Riverside (including all labor, insurance, supervision, training, equipment, and incidentals necessary to provide said service).

The 3-year contract amount of \$1,362,016 includes a 10% contingency for additional unforeseen services that may be required for items such as vandalism, theft and/or decay.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

1. Approve an Agreement for Landscape Maintenance Services with Mariposa Landscapes, Inc., of Irwindale, California, for Landscape and General Outside Maintenance Services for Victoria Avenue Parkways and Medians through June 30, 2025 in the amount of \$1,238,196 plus 10% contingency in the amount of \$123,820 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,362,016; and
2. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Agreement for Landscape Maintenance Services, including making minor and non-substantive changes and with the option to extend for three additional one-year terms.
