Item 8 Budget Refresh Fiscal Year 2025/26

Erin Christmas, Library Director, provided a presentation on the Fiscal Year 2025/26 Budget Refresh and make recommendations as necessary for Budget Engagement Commission and City Council consideration. Following the presentation and discussion there were no recommendations or actions made.

Item 9 Receive Recurring Update on the New SPC Jesus S. Duran Eastside Library

Erin Christmas, Library Director, provided an informational report on the New SPC Jesus S. Duran Eastside Library (Eastside Library). The Eastside Library at Chicago Ave. closed on April 11 and staff are in the process of vacating the property. A

temporary location will be at the Lincoln Park Center beginning services May 6. A mobile library and remote lockers can be accessed throughout the community with a schedule on the city website. The new Eastside Library is in progress with 15 responsive bids that are under review by the purchasing department.

Item 10 Lunch at the Library

Jessica Herdina, Assistant Library Director, provided an informational report on Lunch at the Library. Lunch at the Library is a project of the California State Library, supported with funds from the State of California. Lunch at the Library was developed by the California Library Association and the California Summer Meal Coalition, with support from the David and Lucile Packard Foundation. The California Summer Meal Coalition (CSMC) and California Library Association (CLA) are working with libraries and meal providers across California to offer summer lunch programs that are designed to provide nourishment and summer enrichment for children and teens. All library meal sites provide free summer lunches and engage families with library programs and services.

On January 16, 2025, the Riverside Public Library received notification from the California State Library of the grant award for the Lunch at the Library Program Fiscal Year 2025/26 for the total amount of \$43,366.

This funding will support the Riverside Public Library Lunch at the Library Program for Summer 2025 and engage families with library programs and services.

A staff report will be presented to the City Council on April 22, 2025, to authorize the grant application, receipt of the award and authorize the City Manager to execute the grant documents with the California State Library. The grant term is February 1, 2025, through January 31, 2026,

Jessica Herdina, Assistant Library Director, provided an informational report on the annual Serving with a Purpose Conference that will be held on May 15, 2025, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Ontario Convention Center. The 2025 theme is United in Purpose: Cultivating Belonging, Trust, and a Shared Vision. The Library is sponsoring a table to include Trustee Steinbrick, Friends of the Library and Staff.


Erin Christmas, Library Director, provided updates on training staff received from CALL (California Library Learn) on Storytelling. California State Library Director's meeting on Wednesday.
