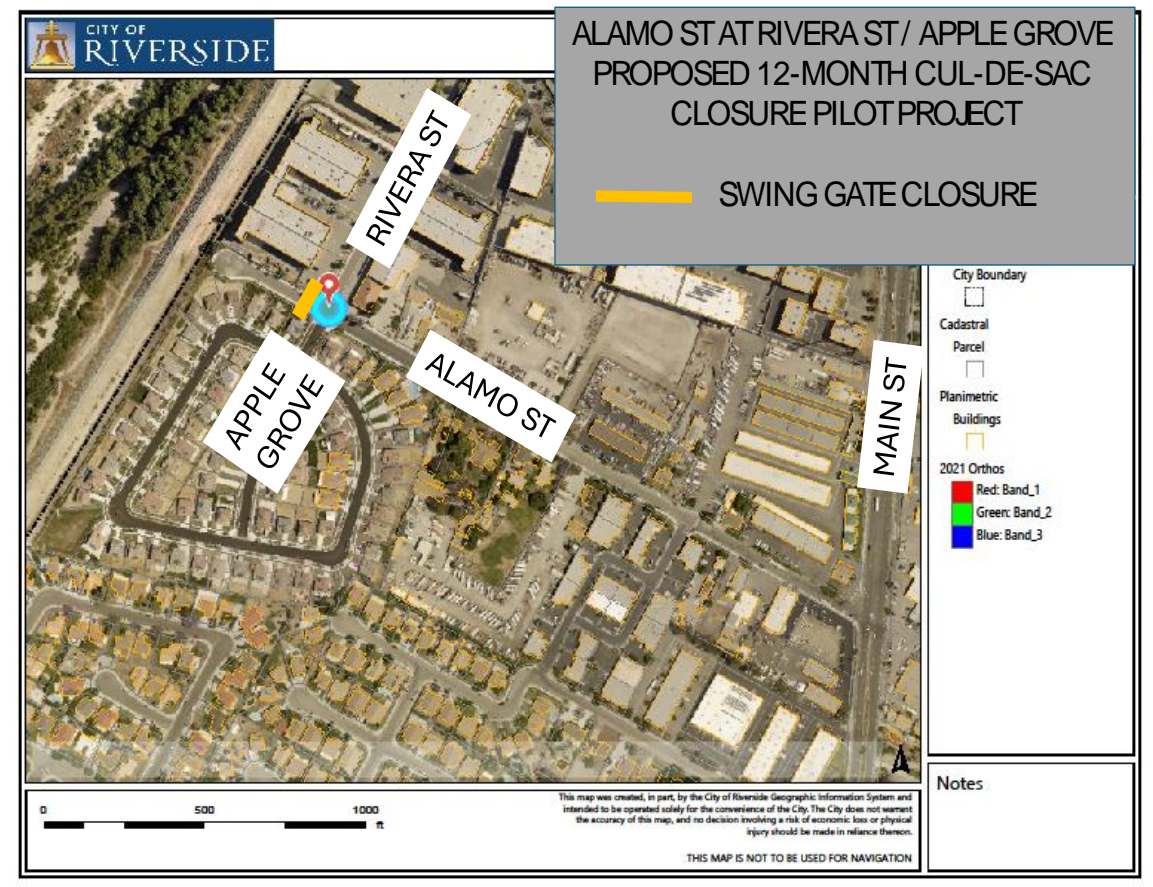
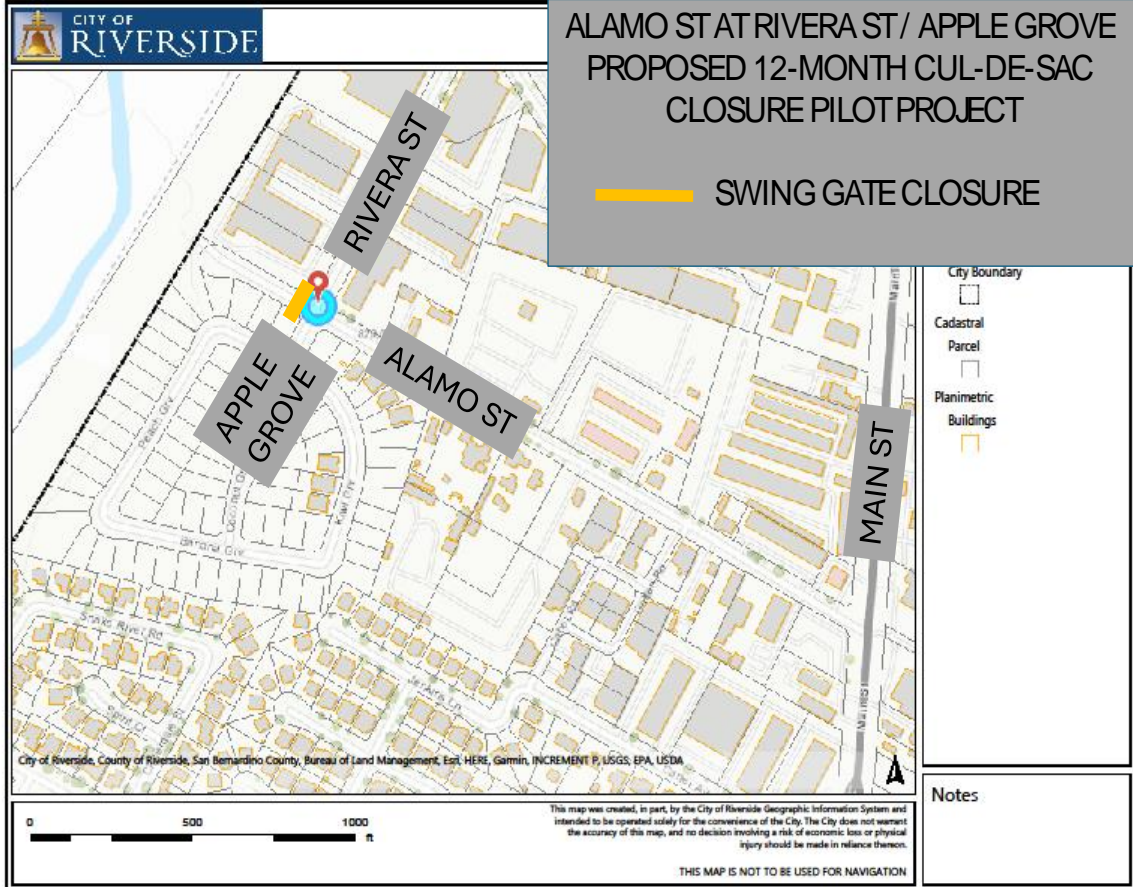

# BACKGROUND

- Riviera Communities HOA and residents have reported ongoing concerns within the cul-de-sac at the westerly end of Alamo St. including:
  1. Illegal dumping;
  2. Parking violations;
  3. Graffiti;
  4. Loitering activity; and
  5. Trash and debris
- Public Works previously installed No Dumping signs within the cul-de-sac and No Stopping signs are also in place

# DISCUSSION

- Public Works' review determined that the cul-de-sac:
  1. Provides no access to the Riviera Communities housing tract or adjacent businesses; and
  2. Though there is a catch basin at the end of the cul-de-sac no utilities run along the cul-de-sac



# DISCUSSION

- To mitigate ongoing issues Public Works is proposing a temporary cul-de-sac closure pilot project on the west leg of Alamo St. at Rivera St. / Apple Grove
- A swing gate and signage to close the cul-de-sac is proposed
- The swing gate will continue to allow cul-de-sac access for emergency and service vehicles

# PILOT PROJECT BENEFITS

- The 12-month pilot project is anticipated to reduce or eliminate illegal dumping and parking within the cul-de-sac and to deter graffiti, loitering activity, and trash and debris
- The swing gate will continue to allow cul-de-sac access for emergency and service vehicles
- The pilot project allows review of effectiveness/impacts and public and emergency/service provider input prior to considering more costly permanent improvements
