



## CITY OF RIVERSIDE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that virtual or in-person public hearings will be held before the City Council of the City of Riverside at 6:15 p.m. on July 7 and 21, 2020, to consider Charter Review Committee recommendations for amendments to the Riverside City Charter generally described as (1) granting the Mayor a vote on all matters requiring action and removing the veto power; (2) requiring an election to fill an elected office vacancy with more than one year remaining on the term; (3) consolidating Mayor and City Council elections with statewide elections; (4) requiring the City Council to submit all proposed Charter amendments to a Charter Review Committee; (5) requiring the City Council to publish an annual report specifying the nature of any material written complaints or whistle-blower complaints alleging fraud, waste, abuse, or criminal conduct; and (6) clean-up items. The City Council will determine Charter amendments to be placed before the voters at the Tuesday, November 3, 2020, election.

During the virtual hearings, the public may comment on the proposed amendments to the Riverside City Charter at 6:15 p.m. on July 7 and 21, 2020, by calling 951-826-8600. If held in-person, the public hearings will be conducted at 6:15 p.m. in the Art Pick Council Chamber at 3900 Main Street, Riverside, CA.
