5 PLANNING CASE DP-2024-00613 (COA): Certificate of Appropriateness request by Mike Khoury of Riverside Hyundai for the removal of approximately 2,821 square feet (including 385 square feet of canopy space) from the rear of the existing 8,716 square foot (including 4,356 square feet canopy space) former Helgeson Buick building, eligible as a City Landmark. The project site is located at 8001 Auto Drive, situated on the west corner of Auto and Detroit Drives, in Ward 5. The Community & Economic Development Department recommends that the Cultural Heritage Board determine the proposal is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review pursuant to Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15331 (Historic Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation), as it constitutes modifications to an existing eligible historic resource that is consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.
