Avenue, the historical University Heights Junior High School; and

historical and architectural contribution to the City of Riverside;


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cultural Heritage Board of the City

School, 2060 University Avenue, be declared Cultural Heritage Board
Landmark #49.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this designation includes woodwork, doors/


