

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, OFFERING A REWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000
4 FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE DETERMINATION OF THE
5 IDENTITY OF, AND THE APPREHENSION OF, THE PERSON OR
6 PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE RECENT HOME INVASION
7 ROBBERIES AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS: 14100 BLOCK OF
8 ASHTON LANE, 18400 BLOCK OF MOSS ROAD AND 1500 BLOCK OF
9 KYLE COURT.

10 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside may offer and pay rewards as authorized by Section 53069.5
11 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

12 WHEREAS, Section 53069.5 specifically authorizes the City to offer and pay a reward, the
13 amount thereof to be determined by the City for information leading to the determination of the
14 identify of, and the apprehension of, any person whose willful misconduct results in injury or death to
15 any person; and

16 WHEREAS, on March 20, 2001, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution
17 No. 19873, approving the Riverside Police Department's Reward Program and authorizing its
18 implementation; and

19 WHEREAS, on May 10, 2022 at about 9:40 p.m., residents located in the 14100 block of
20 Ashton Lane were the victims of a robbery inside their residence that entailed an adult male, his wife,
21 and 11-year old child being robbed at gunpoint by multiple suspects; and

22 WHEREAS, on May 15, 2022 at about 4:40 a.m., residents located in the 18400 block of
23 Moss Road were the victims of a robbery inside their residence that entailed a female victim being
24 woken to a gun being pointed at her and when an adult male victim confronted the suspects he was
25 shot multiple times undergoing life-saving surgery, which he survived so far but he is in critical
26 condition; and

27 WHEREAS, on May 17, 2022 at about 6:30 a.m., an adult female was the victim of a robbery
28 inside her residence located in the 1500 block of Kyle Court, where she was confronted by two armed
suspects and robbed; and

1 WHEREAS, due to the current lack of information to identify the suspects, the frequency of
2 the crimes, and the violence observed it is important to seek the public's help with a reward of \$10,000;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the offer would be consistent with and is taken for the immediate protection of
5 public peace, health, and safety; and

6 WHEREAS, the offense was of such a nature or committed under special circumstances that
7 as a matter of public policy, the City of Riverside should provide a reward as an added inducement or
8 incentive for persons to come forth with information leading to the arrest of the perpetrators; and

9 WHEREAS, the offense was especially heinous, atrocious, or cruel and manifested exceptional
10 depravity; and

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
12 California, that a reward in the amount of \$10,000 is hereby approved and authorized for information
13 leading to the determination of the identity of, and the apprehension of, any person responsible for the
14 acts stated above.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the offer of reward by the City shall be effective for a
16 period of sixty (60) days or for the term of any extension thereof which may be approved by the City
17 Council prior to the termination of the offer of reward. An offer of reward by the City shall terminate
18 by payment, by revocation, or by withdrawal thereof by the City Council by resolution, motion, or
19 council report adopted by a majority vote of the City Council or by expiration of the time period set
20 forth in the resolution offering the reward or any extension thereof which was approved by the City
21 Council while the offer was otherwise effective.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all decisions with respect to the relevance or materiality
23 of information received, whether or not utilized in establishing the determination of the identity of and
24 the apprehension of any one or more persons, and whether such information provides a basis for the
25 payment of a reward, are within the sole discretion of the City Council.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all determinations effective, or dispositive of the offer of
27 reward, shall be within the sole discretion of the City Council and shall be final.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 53069.5, the person or persons
2 responsible for the robberies shall be liable for the amount of any reward paid pursuant to this Section
3 and if the person is an unemancipated minor, his or her parent or guardian shall also be liable for the
4 amount.
