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BACKGROUND

- 1. Riverside Public Utilities (RPU) operates 16 potable water reservoirs.
- 2. The reservoirs distribute potable water over the entire RPU service area.
- 3. Per State Water Resources Control Board guidelines, the reservoirs require periodic inspections to ensure structural integrity.



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DISCUSSION

- 1. The reservoirs will be inspected and cleaned by professional and certified divers while the reservoirs are in operation.
- 2. The work includes inspecting and removing any accumulated sediment and debris from the reservoirs, which includes repair or assessment of any related components such as hatches, submerged metals, stairs, valves, and piping.
- 3. Bid No. RPU-2320 was posted on the city's online bid system.
- 4. Bidding closed on November 30, 2023, with two responsive bidders.

5. Based on the proposals received below, staff has deemed Harper & Associates Engineering Inc of Corona, California as the best overall responsive bidder.
