2 3	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE GRANT OF FUNDS			
4	FROM THE STATE COASTAL CONSERVANCY FOR THE RIVER DISTRICT FEASIBILITY STUDY AND AUTHORIZING THE			
5	EXECUTION OF ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE.

7	WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has established the State Coastal			
8	Conservancy ("Conservancy") under Division 21 of the California Public Resources Code, and			
9	has authorized the Conservancy to award grants to public agencies and nonprofit organizations			
10	to implement the provisions of Division 21; and			
11	WHEREAS, the Conservancy awards grants for projects that it determines are consistent			
12	2 with Division 21 of the Public Resources Code and with the Conservancy's Strategic Plan and			
13	that best achieve the Conservancy's statutory objectives, in light of limited funding; and			
14	WHEREAS, at its April 6, 2023 meeting, the Conservancy adopted a resolution authorizing			
15	a grant of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) to the City of Riverside ("Grantee") for			
16	the River District Feasibility Study ("the Project"); and			
17	WHEREAS, the resolution was adopted by the Conservancy pursuant to, and is included			
18	in, the Conservancy's April 6, 2023 staff recommendation, a copy of which is on file with the			
19	Grantee and with the Conservancy; and			
20	<sup>0</sup> WHEREAS, the Conservancy requires that the governing body of the Grantee certify			
21	through a resolution that it approves the award of Conservancy grant funding and authorizes			
22	the execution by a representative of the Grantee of a Grant Agreement on terms and conditions			
23	required by the Conservancy Grant Agreement No. 22-151.			
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,			
25	California, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Approves the award of grant funding from the State Coastal Conservancy for
 the River District Feasibility Study Project in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
 (\$200,000.00).

4 <u>Section 2</u>: Acknowledges that it has or will have sufficient funds to complete the Project
5 and, if any property is acquired as part of the Project, to operate and maintain the property, and,
6 if any facilities are constructed as a part of the Project, to operate and maintain the facilities for a
7 reasonable period, not less than the useful life of the facilities.

8 Section 3: Agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement and any other agreement or instrument as may be required by the Conservancy and as may be necessary to fulfill the terms of the Grant Agreement and to complete the Project.

Section 4: Authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to act as a representative of the
 Grantee to negotiate and execute on behalf of the Grantee all agreements and instruments
 necessary to complete the Project and to comply with the Conservancy's grant requirements,
 including, without limitation, the Grant Agreement..
