# BACKGROUND

- December 17, 2024 City Council approved use of drones for fireworks enforcement, funding of advanced night operations training, and purchase of drones
- February 25, 2025 City Council introduced ordinance amending RMC Section 1.18.10 to include Social Host Ordinance and allow for use of drones for fireworks enforcement, subsequently adopted March 11, 2025
- March 25, 2025 City Council authorized supplemental appropriation of \$86,106.93 from Measure Z Fund Balance for purchase of drones and advanced training for drone pilots




