## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the program shown above; and

WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require a resolution certifying the approval of application(s) by the applicant's governing board before submission of said application(s) to the State; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside ("Applicant"), if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows, that the City of Riverside:

Section 1: Approves the filing of an application for the Northside Heritage Meadows Project.

<u>Section 2</u>: Certifies that Applicant understands the assurances and certification in the application.

Section 3: Certifies that Applicant or title holder will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project consistent with the land tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do so.

<u>Section 4</u>: Certifies that Applicant will comply with all provisions of Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.

Section 5: If applicable, certifies that the Project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, and disabled access laws, and that prior to commencement of construction all applicable permits will have been obtained.

2	promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and
3	safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1.
4	Section 7: Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations,
5	execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, payment
6	requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project(s).
