Each of which has its own unique challenges and CEQA determinations.

MediCity

As a private consultant, I completed the Mitigated Negative Declaration, the Airport Compatibility Plan, and the presentations for public hearing and public workshop presentation for this project; which is a redevelopment of an existing Wal-Mart store. The end product will be a hospital, along with various doctor's offices. This project is located within the City of Hemet.

Diamond Valley Market

This country store needed a renewal of their Conditional Use Permit. As such, environmental reviews needed to occur, including: water well testing and the dedication of land for endangered species per Riverside County's Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan. I headed up the Conditional Use Permit renewal process through the County of Riverside on behalf of the store owners.

Villages of Lakeview Specific Plan

The Villages of Lakeview is a master-planned community of 3,000 acres that includes over 11,000 dwelling units, recreational facilities, and other land uses. I have been heavily involved the management of this project, both at the County and at Webb Associates, since its inception. There are several innovative planning concepts that are being introduced in this project that Riverside County has never approved before, but are currently very receptive to implementing. These include a unit transfer mechanism, a true mixed-use planning area, and a design guideline refinement process.

This specific plan also encompasses approximately 4,200 dwelling units, and is one of the first specific plans to introduce a mixed-use land use designation in Riverside County on a large scale. Soon after the adoption of the MSHCP, I developed implementation tools and clear procedures for both public employees and the development community. Those processes are still in place today.

During my tenure at the County, I developed processes for the Riverside County Planning Department that greatly increased work efficiency and CEQA compliance. Those procedures are still in place today.

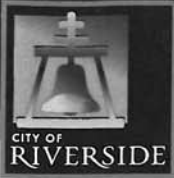

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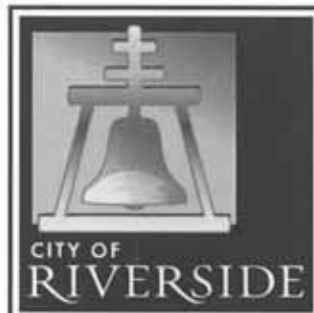
