

#### **BACKGROUND**

- Residents have reported cut-through truck traffic on Fillmore St. from the southerly City limits to Indiana Ave. believed to be bypassing the existing axle restriction on the parallel segment of La Sierra Ave.
- The Public Works Department may establish weight limit or axle restrictions to prohibit use of select streets by larger commercial vehicles.
- Proposed weight limit restrictions assist in preserving the pavement and may improve safety and reduce noise.

## DISCUSSION

- Public Works is proposing establishment of a 5-ton weight limit restriction on the segment of Fillmore St. from the southerly City limits to Indiana Ave.
- The weight limit restriction is recommended based on the residential nature of this two-lane collector roadway which has single family residential homes situated along the street and encompasses Orrenmaa

Elementary School.

### INTENT OF PROPOSED WEIGHT LIMIT RESTRICTION

- 1. To restrict commercial truck traffic use of Fillmore St. that bypass the existing La Sierra Ave. axle restriction;
- 2. Improve safety and operations within the neighborhood and adjacent to Orrenmaa Elementary School;
- 3. Preserve the residential nature of the street and condition of the pavement; and
- 4. Reduce resulting noise along the street segment.

#### **COLLABORATION WITH COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE**

- The City coordinated with the County of Riverside who has agreed to install advance signage should the proposed weight limit restriction on the designated segment of Fillmore St. be approved.
- The City will fabricate the advance signage which would be installed and subsequently maintained by the County.

FILMORE NORTH OF ARIZONA VEHICLE CLASSIFICATION STUDY

Northbound Filmore St:

1.2% Daily Total Trucks Total Vehicles (all types) 1,977

Southbound Filmore St:

0.6% Daily Total Trucks Total Vehicles (all types) 2,100

NB + SB Filmore St:

0.8% Daily Total Trucks Total Vehicles (all types) 4,077

CONCLUSION:

Based on an average daily traffic count in October 2023, Filmore St is currently operating with truck / heavy vehicle traffic at 0.8% of the total daily traffic. Filmore is a residential street with direct access to Orrenmaa Elementary School. Truck axle restrictions are recommended.
