



MEASURE Z – BID 8167 FY 2024/25 STREET PRESERVATION

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BACKGROUND

- Public Works budgets a portion of the State Gas Tax, the County Measure A Sales Tax, and the City's Measure Z and uses tax revenues for pavement rehabilitation and preservation of city streets.
- Public Works utilizes a Pavement Management Program (PMP) to collect and analyze pavement data to prioritize maintenance and repair projects.



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BACKGROUND

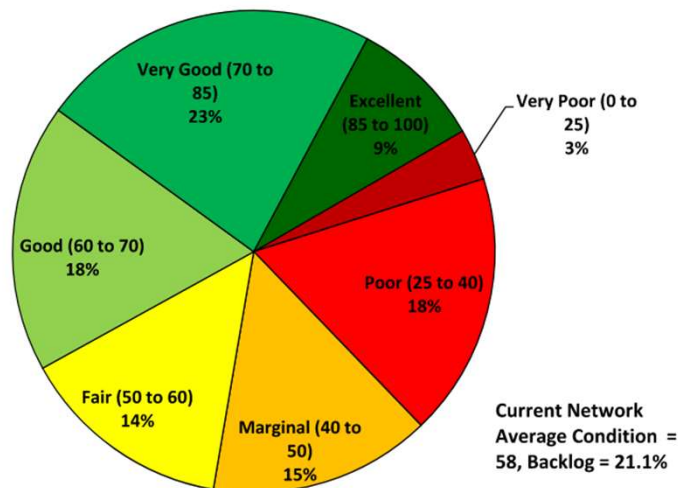
- This project aims to preserve streets in fair to good condition to extend their pavement life using the City's Measure Z funds.
- Preventative maintenance is used on streets with pavement condition index (PCI) scores of 60 and higher. The cost for these surface treatments is low compared to resurfacing.

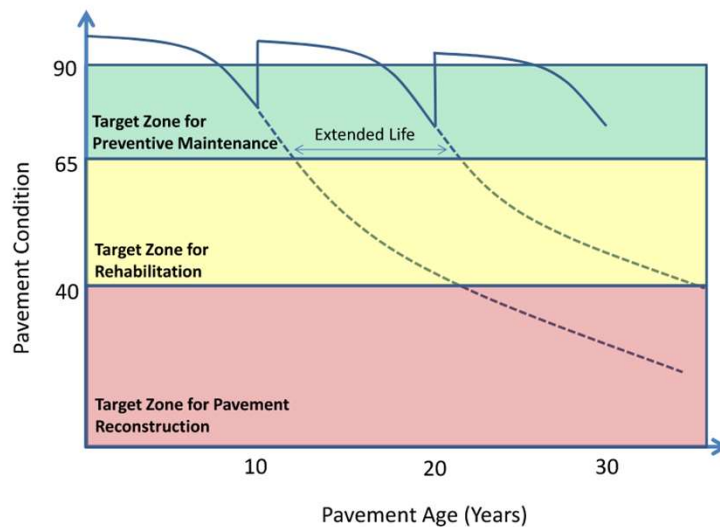
Distribution of the City's Pavement System on a Condition Scale

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CURRENT PROJECT

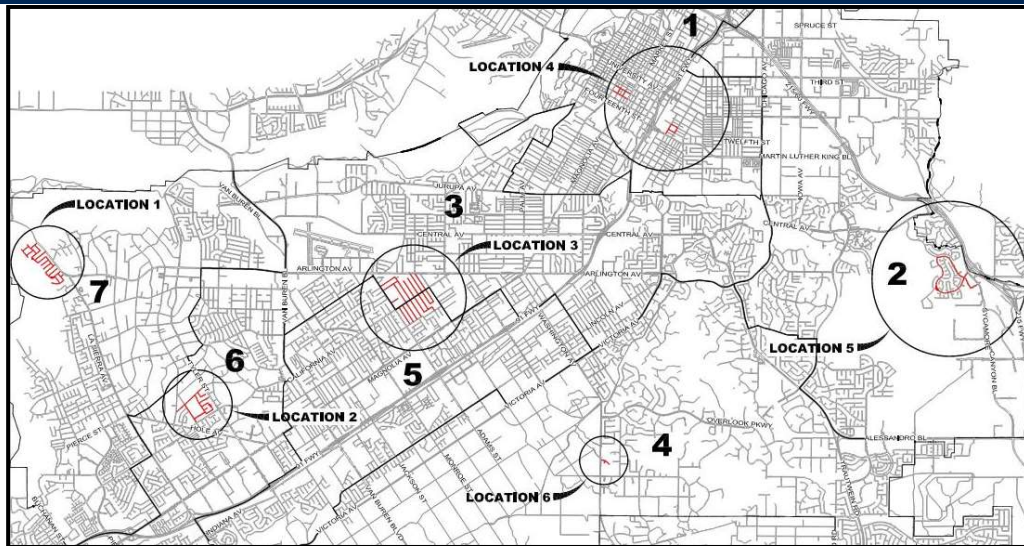
1. Pavement preservation for 11.6 miles of streets including:
 - Slurry preservation and minor pavement resurfacing of 9.5 street centerline miles, and
 - Asphalt-rubber aggregate membrane cape seal of 2.1 centerline miles
2. New traffic pavement markings and signage upgrades at all preservation locations.



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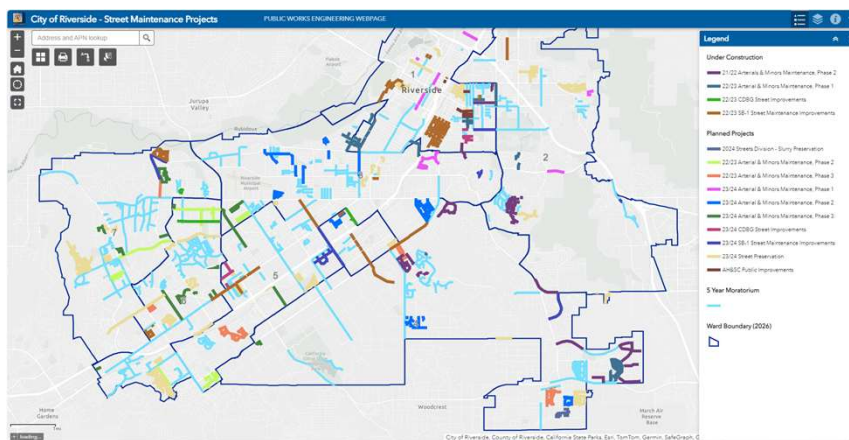
LOCATION MAP

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RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Reject the bid submitted by Roy Allen Slurry Seal, Inc. of Santa Fe Springs, CA as non-responsive;
2. Award a construction contract for Bid No. 8167 for Fiscal Year 2024/25 Streets Preservation to Union Pavement Services, Inc., of Jurupa Valley, California, in the amount of \$1,949,270.65; and
3. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the construction contract with Union Pavement Services, Inc., including making minor non-substantial changes.
