ARPA BACKGROUND

1. American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), created in 2021
 - **\$350 billion in nationwide assistance** for pandemic related health and economic recovery
2. Riverside Received **two allocations** of funding **totaling \$75,435,188**
3. City Council approved **four ARPA expenditure plans** funding **50+ local projects**

ARPA BACKGROUND

1. Many American cities took APRA allocations as complete, “revenue loss” using the entire funding to repay costs for municipal services during the pandemic.

a. **Riverside took a hybrid approach**, using some ARPA assistance to fund critical City functions during the pandemic, while also making a variety of grant eligible projects available to assist community partners and residents that suffered economic hardships during Covid-19 shutdowns.

ARPA PROJECTS



Northside Agricultural Center

- Funding to assist with the infrastructure of an innovative agricultural training center.
- Workforce component to include tuition free Small-Farm Apprenticeship Program for 40 participants.
- **Benefits:** Workforce Development and Sustainable Farming Project.



Captain Tim Strack Park



- Park renovations honoring a fallen firefighter who championed better health for fire personnel.
- Renovations include: 2 shaded playgrounds, turf conversion, and seating & picnic table additions.
- **Benefits:** Improving community well-being with pivotal park renovations and improvements.

ARPA PROJECTS



Public Utility Assistance

- Purchase of 10 New Solid Waste Operations Vehicles.
- Financial assistance for refuse accounts to fund the SHARE program.
- **Benefits:** Service enhancement to Riverside Residents.



Services to Vulnerable Communities



- 180,000 Meals provided to Seniors and Youth.
- Over 10,000 scholarships to Riverside Youth to participate in fee-based classes.
- **Benefits:** Health and wellness services for those Residents hit hardest by the pandemic.

ARPA PROGRAMS



Library Infrastructure & Outreach

- Construction and infrastructure of remote library lockers, complete with daily delivery services.
- Purchase of over 36,000 books and additional library materials.
- **Benefits:** Providing information services to the community.



Behavioral Health Support Assistance

- Over 6,000 services and classes provided in Behavioral Health field for Riverside Residents.
- Services provided across 17 locations throughout the City.
- **Benefits:** Critical Human Service Support.

Small Business Assistance

- Emergency Rental Assistance for 468 Riverside Small Businesses.
- 82 Riverside Businesses received funding for security improvements and enhancements.
- **Benefits:** Direct Financial Support for small business owners.



Childcare Support Program



- Childcare Assistance for 161 Families, with services spanning infant to afterschool options.
- To date, provided affordable childcare options for 247 children.
- **Benefits:** Critical Financial Support for Riverside Families.
