MINUTES

Chair Perry called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m.

REVOCATION OF MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT - HEALING HANDS SPA -  
6702 MAGNOLIA AVENUE

Following discussion, it was moved by Member Adams and seconded by Vice Chair Melendrez to deny the appeal of Hao Zhang, owner of Healing Hands Spa located at 6702 Magnolia Avenue, of the Police Department revocation of a Massage Establishment Permit based on the evidence presented. The denial is based on Section 5.52.130 of the Riverside Municipal Code and, specifically, on the grounds that (1) the holder of the establishment permit or certificate of registration is acting in a manner (a) contrary to the provisions of this code; (b) that constitutes a public nuisance; and (c) that is detrimental to the health, safety or welfare of the city or its inhabitants; and (2) the holder of the establishment permit or their agents, contractors or employees has violated the law in connection with the operation of this business and/or failed to cooperate with the Riverside Police Department. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Perry advised that pursuant to the vote, the Public Safety Committee is hereby denying the appeal of Hao Zhang, owner of Healing Hands Spa. The decision of the Public Safety Committee is final with no further right of appeal to the City Council. Because there is no provision for reconsideration of the decision, or for a written decision or written findings supporting the decision in any applicable provision of any statute, charter, or rule, this decision is final today. The appellant may seek judicial review of the decision pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1094.5 by filing a petition with the Riverside County Superior Court. The time within which judicial review must be sought is governed by Section 1094.6.
