# **BACKGROUND**

- 1. On March 11, 2021, American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Law came into effect
- 2. ARPA established the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to provide resources to support communities
- 3. On November 9, 2021, the City Council approved the ARPA Funding Expenditure Category Plan for the first allocation of \$36,767,594 of which \$450,000 was allocated for Public Health Mental Health Support
- 4. On January 10, 2023, the City Council approved the ARPA Subrecipient Agreement with Path of Life Ministries for \$200,000 of the ARPA funds for the Social Work Intern Program known as the Love Your Neighbor Collaborative (LYNC) that serves homeless individuals and families
