TRANSPORTATION BOARD RECOMMENDATION


- On August 7, 2024, the Transportation Board (Board) reviewed the proposal to establish a 25 MPH speed limit zone on Appian Wy. from Horace St. to Hawarden Dr. and revise the existing speed limit zones on Acorn St. from Jurupa Ave. to Central Ave. and on the segment of Mission Grove Pkwy. from Alessandro Blvd. to Trautwein Rd. reducing the speed limits from 45 MPH to 40 MPH; and
- 2. The Board voted unanimously to recommend the proposed speed limit zone establishment on Appian Way and revisions on Acorn Street and segment of Mission Grove Parkway.

DISCUSSION

1. Appian Way from Horace St. to Hawarden Dr. is a two-lane local road which does not meet CVC 25 MPH prima facie criteria. A Traffic and Engineering Survey concluded the 85th percentile speed to be 30 MPH.


As a result of survey findings and noted unusual conditions establishment of a 25 MPH speed limit is recommended;

DISCUSSION (CONTINUED)

3. Mission Grove Pkwy. from Alessandro Blvd. to Trautwein Rd. is a four-lane arterial roadway with an existing 45 MPH speed limit. An updated speed survey concluded the 85th percentile speed to be 42 MPH. As a result of the survey

findings revision of the existing speed limit zone reducing the speed limit from 45 MPH to 40 MPH is recommended.

4. Airport Drive from Arlington Avenue to Flight Road is a fourlane roadway serving Riverside Municipal Airport area with light industrial businesses fronting both sides of the street segment. The survey of Airport Drive concluded the current

85th percentile speed to be 26 MPH. As a result of survey findings establishment of a 25 MPH speed limit is recommended;

DISCUSSION (CONTINUED)

5. Gemende Drive from Airport Drive to its easterly terminus is a two-lane roadway serving Riverside Municipal Airport hanger access and airport-related businesses. The survey of Airport Drive concluded the current 85th percentile speed to

be 32 MPH. As a result of survey findings and noted unusual conditions, establishment of a 25 MPH speed limit is recommended;
