Existing Conditions:

- ~ 8.5-acre park consisting of trees and turf surrounded by single family residential homes. Existing electrical poles with sporadic lighting running down the middle of the park.

Project Funding:

- \$250,000 – Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- \$1,800,000 - American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)
- \$403,000 - Measure Z
- **\$2,453,000 – Total Budget**

- Picnic Tables
- Concrete Pathways
- Solar Lighting throughout
- Solar Irrigation Controller and General Irrigation System Improvements
