# City Council Memorandum

**SUBJECT: AWARD BID NO. 7468 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 2016-2017 CITY WIDE CURB, GUTTER AND SIDEWALK REPAIR TO L.C. PAVING & SEALING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$510,736.73**

## **ISSUE:**

Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7468 to replace damaged concrete curbs, gutters, and sidewalks at various locations throughout the City, install a bus pad on University Avenue, and modify the existing traffic signal and striping at Fourteenth Street and Main Street to L.C. Paving & Sealing, Inc., of San Marcos, California, in the amount of \$510,736.73.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the City Council:

1. Award a construction contract for Bid No. 7468 – 2016-2017 City Wide Curb, Gutter and Sidewalk Repair to L.C. Paving & Sealing, Inc., of San Marcos, California, in the amount of \$510,736.73; and
2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the construction contract with L.C. Paving and Sealing, Inc., including making minor non-substantial changes.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The 2016-2017 City Wide Curb, Gutter and Sidewalk Repair (Project) will construct improvements at various geographic locations (Attachment 1) throughout the City. The Project will:

1. Remove and replace damaged curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, cross gutters and pedestrian ramps;
2. Modify the existing traffic signal and striping at the intersection of Fourteenth Street and Main Street; and
3. Install a concrete bus pad on the southerly side of University Avenue, just easterly of Market Street.

On June 9, 2017, seven bids were received for the construction of the Project (Attachment 2). The lowest responsive bid was from L.C. Paving & Sealing, Inc., in the amount of \$510,736.73,

which is 16.3% under the Engineer's Estimate.

The Purchasing Services Manager concurs with the award recommendation.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The estimated total Project cost including design, construction, construction engineering, and contingencies is \$650,000 (Table 1).
