SUBJECT: SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR YOUTH SPORTS OFFICIALS
AND SCOREKEEPERS WITH DANNY FULLER DBA SPORTS INNOVATORS IN
THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000 PER YEAR AND TO EXTEND THE
TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020

ISSUE:

Approval of a Second Amendment to the Agreement with Danny Fuller DBA Sports Innovators Riverside CA for administering officials for youth sports programs extending the term for an additional one-year period commencing July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council:

1. Approve a Second Amendment to the Agreement for the Youth Sports Officials and Scorekeepers with Danny Fuller DBA Sports Innovators in an amount not to exceed \$20,000 per year and to extend the term for an additional one year period commencing July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020; and
2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the Second Amendment to the Agreement for the Youth Sports Officials and Scorekeepers including making minor and non-substantive changes.

BACKGROUND:

On July 26, 2016, the City entered into an Operating Agreement with Danny Fuller, DBA Sports Innovators to manage and schedule sports officials and scorekeepers for the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department's (PRCSD) youth sports programs. The agreement period was from July 2016 – June 30, 2018, with the option to renew for three additional one year terms, not to exceed five years total.

On August 7, 2018, the City Council approved the First Amendment to the Agreement extending the term through June 30, 2019. The compensation of the agreement was not to exceed \$20,000 per year. For fiscal year 2018-2019, the City paid \$15,444 to Sports Innovators for assigning officials for 376 of youth sports games.

DISCUSSION:

Sports Innovators is an experienced contractor providing officiating services to a variety of leagues in the surrounding area including: 7th Day Adventist Programs in Redlands, City of Loma Linda, City of Moreno Valley, The Grove Church and California School of the Deaf Riverside.

By contracting with Sports Innovators, the PRCSD staff and youth sport program participants will continue to benefit from a service provider that delivers extensive experience in official's management and whose focus is on safety, sportsmanship and youth development.

Staff estimates that during the 2019-2020 PRCSD youth sports season, Sports Innovators will assign more than 440 youth sports games.

Over the last three years, Sports Innovators contract totaled \$60,220. The extension to the agreement surpasses the \$50,000 threshold set by Administrative policy 07.014.00.

The Purchasing Manager concurs that the extension to the agreement is in compliance with Purchasing Resolution No. 23256.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total fiscal impact of the action is \$20,000. Funds are available in Recreation budget designated for Youth Sports account 5205005221- 42104000.
