SUBJECT: WATER HIGHLIGHTS – March 2017

Domestic water production for the month of March 2017 totaled 4,128 acre-feet (1,345 million gallons), with the following resource mix:

- Bunker Hill Basin: 67%
- Riverside Basin: 33%
- Purchased Water: 0%

Peak water usage for the month of March 2017, was 56 million gallons per day (mgd) and occurred on March 30th.

Under the Cooperative Agreement for Water Production and Conveyance with Western Municipal Water District, 577 AF of potable water and 12 AF of irrigation water were delivered to WMWD.

There were no significant events for the water system in March 2017.

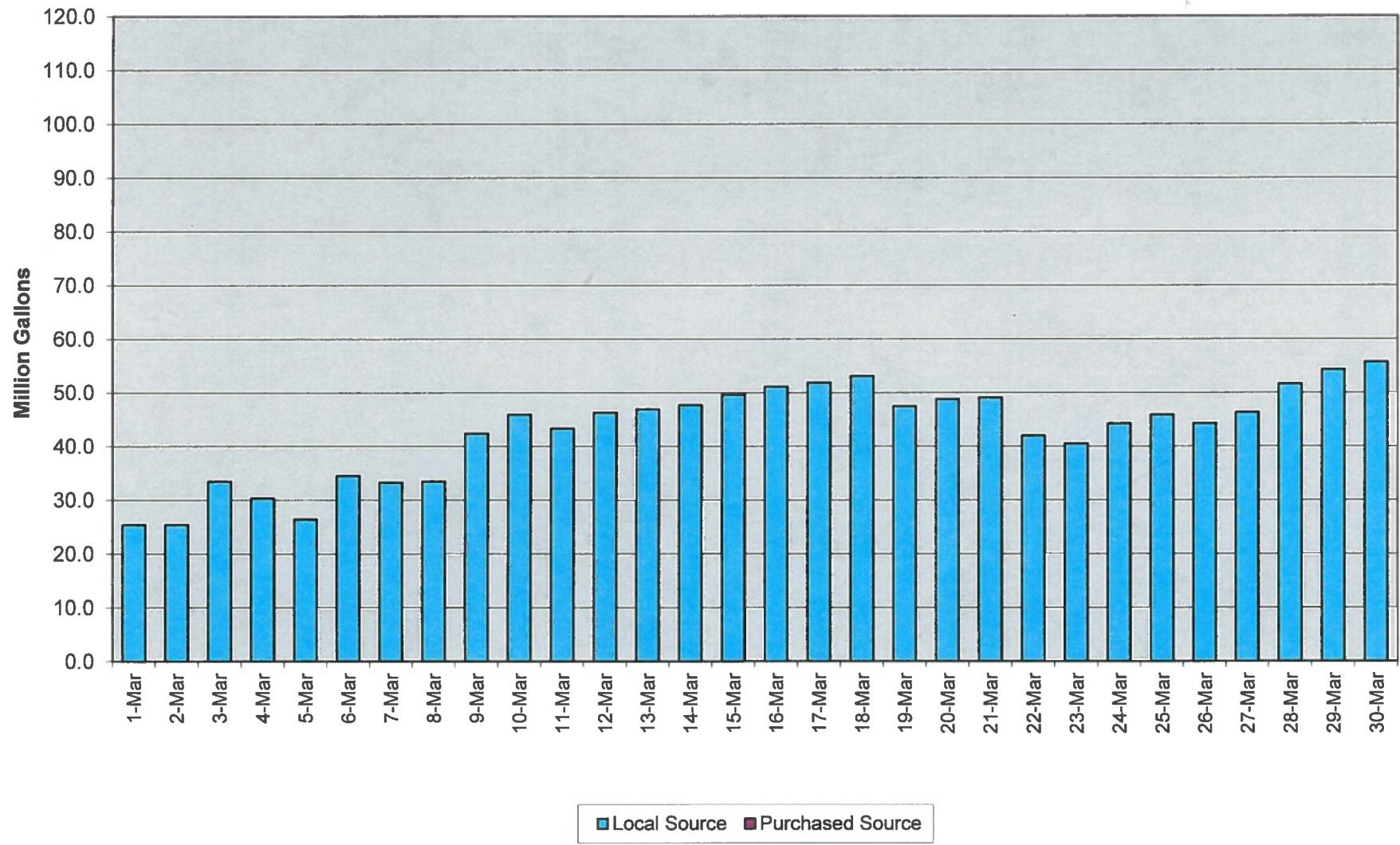
