- 4. Separate work order for installation of onsite distribution facilities

- New 4kV underground electrical line extension for new logistics center
- 2. Improvements will increase electric system reliability
- 3. All civil infrastructure facilities will be constructed by the developer
- 4. Customer funded for all facilities required to serve project
- Extra facilities required by Utility will result in credit to Applicant



SCOPE OF WORK

- Construct new underground distribution facilities to serve project
- 2. Install 29,826 linear feet of conduit total (19,884 in reimbursement)
- 3. Install 17,250 feet of primary underground cable
- 4. Install one pad-mounted switch and seven vaults
- 5. 5 months to complete
