BACKGROUND

1. On September 17, 2002, Riverside City Council adopted Resolution No. 20266, incorporating the area of Annexation 87
2. At the time, RPU had no electric infrastructure to support the annexation of Woodcrest Christian School
3. RPU now has infrastructure to support the addition of Woodcrest Christian School onto the electric system
4. RPU is currently working on transferring the existing electric service for Woodcrest Christian School from SCE to RPU
5. A second phase will be completed later, and will include surrounding areas along Van Buren Boulevard, leveraging existing electric utility infrastructure

DISCUSSION

1. This project will convert the electric distribution facilities serving Woodcrest Christian School from SCE to RPU
2. New primary cables, transformer, junction cabinet, and related electric distribution facilities will be installed
3. The project will ensure reliable electric service for many years to Woodcrest Christian School fed from RPU
4. RPU issued the Request for Bid to qualified and preapproved contractors through Energy Delivery's Contractors panel for the civil structure work
5. The design, inspection, and electric field work will be completed by RPU staff

PROJECT LOCATION

1. The project is located on the Woodcrest Christian School Campus
2. Electric service disruptions will be coordinated to minimize impact to the School and surrounding area
3. RPU and SCE are coordinating specific electric service cutover logistics and final connection date once underground infrastructure is installed

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Installation of one (1) pad mounted junction cabinet (PJC), and one pull box
2. Installation of one (1) 500 kVA transformer
3. Installation of 1,540 feet of conduit and approximately 770 feet of trench
4. Installation of approximately 850 circuit feet of underground feeder cable
5. Approximately eight (8) weeks to complete scope of work
6. Civil work to be completed by Contractor
7. Electrical work to be completed by RPU field forces

BID RESULTS

1. On April 16, 2026, Informal Bid was sent to pre-approved vendors from RPU's Contractors panel
2. On April 21, 2026, RPU hosted a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting, with eight (8) companies in attendance
3. On May 7, 2026, Bid No. 2605723 closed, and seven (7) bids were received
