

1 RESOLUTION NO. 23222

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO LEVY AN ANNUAL
4 ASSESSMENT IN THE ARLINGTON BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
5 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018, GENERALLY DESCRIBING THE
6 IMPROVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN, AND FIXING
7 THE TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY
8 COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ON THE LEVY OF THE PROPOSED
9 ASSESSMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 36534 OF THE CALIFORNIA
10 STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE.

11 WHEREAS, the Arlington Business Improvement District in the Arlington area of the City of
12 Riverside (the "District") was established by Ordinance No. 6626 for (a) general business
13 promotions, (b) business activities, (c) promotion of events, (d) advertising to promote area
14 businesses, (e) landscaping, (f) clean-up activities, and (g) physical improvements; and

15 WHEREAS, the District is located in the Arlington business area of the City of Riverside, and
16 is described as generally between Arlington Avenue on the north, along Van Buren to Lincoln on the
17 south, and a portion along Magnolia Avenue from Tyler on the west to Jackson Street on the east;
18 said area is more fully shown on the plat of the area, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", entitled
19 "Arlington BID"; and

20 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside has received the annual report of the
21 Arlington Business Partnership ("Report"), acting as the advisory board of the District for the fiscal
22 year of 2016/2017; and

23 WHEREAS, the report of the Arlington Business Partnership as submitted to the City Council
24 in August, 2017, more fully details the improvements and activities which shall be provided, as well
25 as the proposed assessments to be levied, for the fiscal year beginning November 1, 2017; and

26 WHEREAS, the Report is on file with the City Clerk.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
28 California, pursuant to Section 36534 of the California Streets & Highways Code, as follows:

29 Section 1: It is the intention of the City Council to levy and collect an assessment within
30 the District for the fiscal year beginning November 1, 2017, at a rate not to exceed the current rate of
31 ninety percent (90%) of the non-discounted annual City Business Tax charge and not to exceed
32 \$400.00 per business.


33 Section 2: The Report of the Arlington Business Partnership more fully details the

1 improvements and activities which include, but are not limited to: (a) general business promotions,
2 (b) business activities, (c) promotion of events, (d) advertising to promote area businesses, (e)
3 landscaping, (f) clean-up activities, and (g) physical improvements, as well as details of the proposed
4 assessments to be levied for the fiscal year beginning November 1, 2017. The Report is on file with
5 the City Clerk.


6 Section 3: Notice is hereby given that the City Council will hold a public hearing on the
7 levy of the proposed assessment for the fiscal year of 2017/2018 on September 26, 2017, at the hour
8 of 3:00 p.m. at the regular meeting of the City Council to be held at the regular place of meeting at
9 said time in the Council Chambers at the Riverside City Hall at 3900 Main Street in the City of
10 Riverside, California. Any protests or objections to the proposed levy of assessment may be made
11 orally or in writing by any interested person. However, the form and manner of such protests or
12 objections shall comply with Section 36524 and 36525 of the California Streets and Highways Code.

13 Section 4: The City Clerk shall give notice of the public hearing by causing the
14 Resolution of Intention to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not less
15 than seven days before the public hearing. Further, the City shall provide notice of the public hearing
16 to each holder of a business license tax certificate within the designated Arlington Business
17 Improvement District by mail, postage prepaid.
