ISSUE:

Receive an update on upcoming events that the Community Events Ad Hoc Committee wishes to attend.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Human Relations Commission discuss whether to approve the attendance of the following upcoming events that the Community Events Ad Hoc Committee wishes to attend as a group:

1. Riverside Pride/Civil Rights Institute Civic Engagement Workshop and Resource Fair – Wednesday, June 12, 5:30-8:00pm.
2. 4th Annual Juneteenth Celebration - Saturday, June 15, 1:00-6:00pm

BACKGROUND:

At the Human Relations Commission (HRC) meeting on January 31, 2024, the commission voted to establish a Community Events Ad Hoc Committee with the goal of increasing public awareness of the HRC and its mission.

DISCUSSION:

In order to receive approval from the HRC the Community Events Ad Hoc Committee will list 2-3 upcoming events that they are interested in attending as a group each month. The Chair and Community Events Ad Hoc Committee members will be responsible for determining which members will attend the approved events. Any Commissioners who wish to attend events individually may state the name and date of events verbally at the monthly meeting to obtain approval from the Commission. This item will remain on the agenda as an on-going discussion item each month.
