



Update on Mission Inn Booster Pump Station at Loring Park

Riverside Public Utilities

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BACKGROUND

1. 480 square foot (SF) pre-cast concrete pump station building (123 SF within Loring Park)
2. Approximately 4,200 SF of grading for booster station building and driveway access, and installation of surrounding landscaping and irrigation systems
3. Installation of 5,250 LF of pipeline within Loring Park, and neighboring streets



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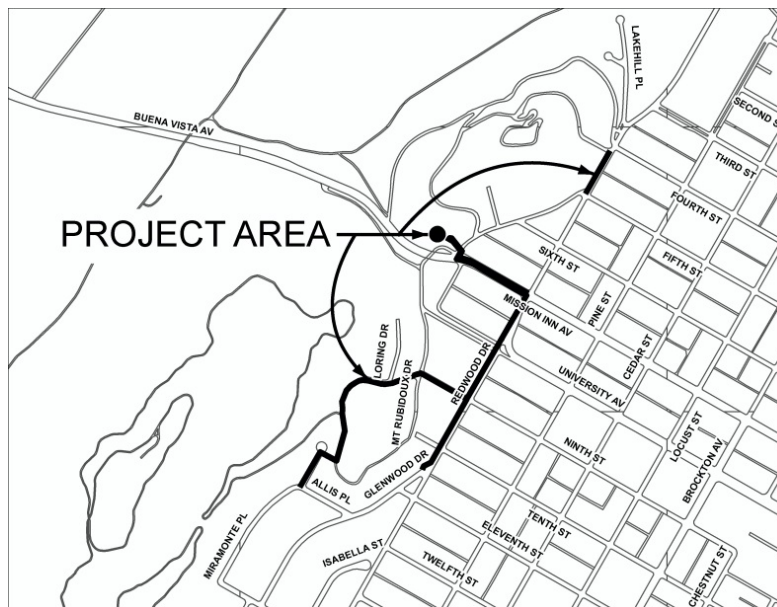
BACKGROUND (CONT'D.)

4. Improves water pressure and fire flow
5. RPU to provide Parks and Rec with increased water pressure and upsized electrical transformer
6. March 15, 2017 - Cultural Heritage Board (CHB) requested continuation; referred project to subcommittee of CHB for design
7. May 17, 2017 – Certificate of Appropriateness approved by CHB



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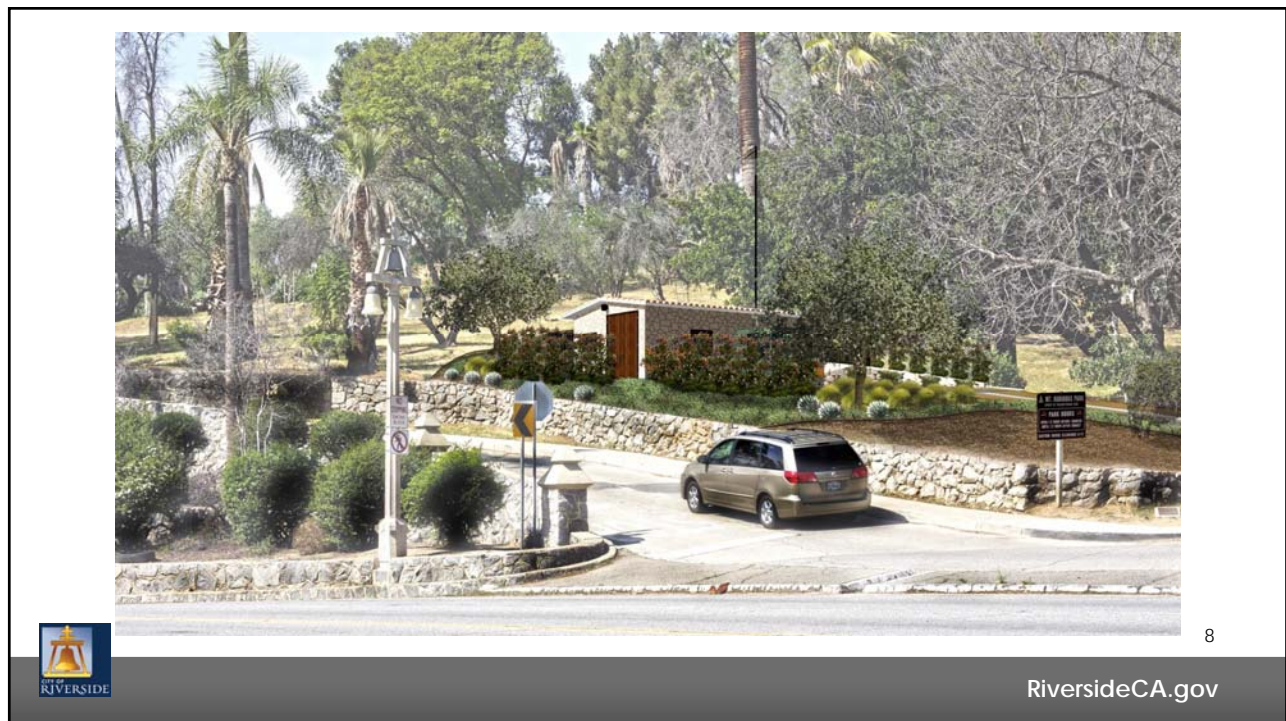
