### MINUTES

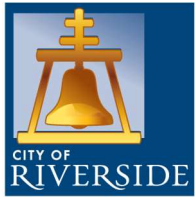
The minutes of the meeting on June 26, 2024, were approved as presented.

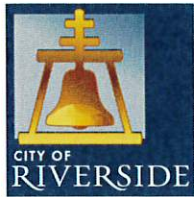
