SUBJECT: RIVERSIDE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANT (RWQCP) – PURCHASE OF TWO PORTABLE DIESEL POWERED GENERATORS FROM VOLVO CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES

ISSUE:

The issue for City Council consideration is approval to issue a purchase order in the amount of \$98,476.08 to Volvo Construction Equipment and Services for the purchase of two portable 100 kW diesel powered generators.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council approve the issuance of a purchase order to Volvo Construction Equipment and Services for the purchase of two portable 100 kW diesel powered generators in the amount of \$98,476.08.

BACKGROUND:

The RWQCP utilizes portable generators to provide power during equipment maintenance or repair activities at the RWQCP and at various sewer and storm water lift stations in the event of a power failure. Under the 2013 Portable Engine Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) the City has until January 1, 2017 to replace diesel powered generators that do not meet the ATCM's requirements. The Public Works Department is seeking approval to purchase two new generators that meet the ATCM requirements.

On April 29, 2015, the City received 5 bids for two 100 Kilowatt diesel generators. Volvo Construction Equipment and Services submitted the lowest bid of \$98,476.08.

The Purchasing Services and Risk Manager concur with the above recommendation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no impact to the General Fund. The cost of the generators is \$98,476.08 and sufficient funds are available in the Public Works Department Sewer Division Account No. 4125410-462200.
