SUBJECT: BOARD AND COMMISSION RESIGNATIONS AND APPOINTMENT

ISSUE:

Accept the resignations of Chloe R. Arias from the Human Relations Commission and Darrell L. Ament from the Board of Public Utilities; and appoint Nicholas R. Chitwood to the Citywide seat on the Human Relations Commission.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council:

1. Accept the resignations of Chloe R. Arias from the Human Relations Commission and Darrell L. Ament from the Board of Public Utilities, effective immediately, and request the City Clerk to process the vacancies; and
2. Appoint Nicholas R. Chitwood to the Citywide seat on the Human Relations Commission for a term ending March 1, 2020.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

Resignations

On September 20, 2016, the City Clerk's Office received the resignation of Chloe R. Arias from the Human Relations Commission, effective immediately. Her term on the Commission expires March 1, 2020. Ms. Arias holds a Citywide seat on the Commission.

On September 22, 2016, the City Clerk received the resignation of Darrell L. Ament from the Board of Public Utilities, effective immediately. His term on the Board expires March 1, 2018. Mr. Ament represented Ward 3 on the Board.

Pursuant to Charter Section 802, each board and commission must have at least one representative from each of the Council Wards. The vacancies created by the resignations of Ms. Arias and Mr. Ament will be filled with registered voters in compliance with the Charter requirement.

Appointment

Mayor Bailey recommends appointment of Nicholas R. Chitwood to the Citywide seat on the Human Relations Commission to fill an unexpired term through March 1, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Board and Commission administration costs are included annually in the City Clerk's Department budget.
