## BACKGROUND

1. On May 13, 1901, Elizabeth Paine granted an indenture to the Riverside Water Company.
2. On May 22, 1901, the City as successor-in-interest to the Riverside Water Company was granted access to the property to extract water by means of artesian wells.
3. On May 13, 1961, the Paine Hot Well Agreement allowed for the construction of up to six (6) wells on the property.

## EASEMENT LOCATION AREA




