Aquamotion Ability is dedicated to helping transform the health and well-being of senior citizens and disabled individuals within the Inland Empire through a high quality water aerobics program that provides guidance and training for being fit and healthy.

The group provides the Inland Empire with community theatre focused on social issues, breaking down social and economic barriers.

Full Circle Players is committed to equity, diversity, and inclusion as it works to create world class theatre in Riverside and beyond. The group holds itself to high artistic and personal standards, to create exceptional art, guided by thoughtful resources, stewardship, and a deep commitment to education and audience engagement.
