#### **BACKGROUND**

- 1. Public Works budgets a portion of the State Gas Tax, the County Measure A Sales Tax, and the City's Measure Z and uses tax revenues for pavement rehabilitation and preservation of city streets.
- 2. The Public Works Department (Public Works) utilizes a Pavement Management Program (PMP) to collect and analyze pavement data to prioritize maintenance and repair projects.

### **BACKGROUND**


- 3. This project aims to preserve streets in fair to good condition to extend their pavement life using the City's Measure Z funds.
- Preventative maintenance is used on streets with pavement condition index (PCI) scores of 60 and higher. The cost for these surface treatments is low compared to resurfacing.


## **CURRENT PROJECT**

- 1. Slurry preservation and minor pavement resurfacing of 27 street centerline miles including collector roads:
  - Collett Ave, Diana Ave, Wells Ave, De Anza Ave, Comer Ave; and Ransom Rd
- 2. New traffic pavement markings and signage upgrades at all preservation locations.
