A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION FOR, AND ACCEPTANCE OF, THE OUTDOOR EQUITY GRANTS PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEARS 2024-2025 – 2026-2027 OFFERED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION OFFICE OF GRANTS AND LOCAL SERVICES FOR THE EASTSIDE DISCOVERS NATURE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Outdoor Equity Grants Program, setting up necessary procedures governing the application; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of the application before submission of said application to the State; and

WHEREAS, successful applicants will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the Outdoor Equity Grants Program for the Eastside Discovers Nature Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

1. Approves the filing of an application for grant funds for the Eastside Discover Nature Program, for the Fiscal Years 2024-2025 – 2026-2027, in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00), and
2. Agrees to, and if awarded, does accept the Grant funds in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00); and
3. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer or designee to record an increase in revenues, and a like expenditure, in an amount not to exceed \$700,000 in Fiscal Years 2024/2025 - 2026/2027 Outdoor Equity Grants Program in accounts to be established by the Finance Department in the City's Grants and Restricted Funds Accounts; and
4. Certifies that said applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the program included in this application, the sufficient funds to complete the

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program; and

5. Certifies that if the grant is awarded, the applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate the program as described in the Grant Administration Guide; and

6. Certifies that the applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions constrained in the contract shown in the Grant Administration Guide; and

7. Delegates the authority to the City Manager, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Grant Scope; and

8. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.
