A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22451 KNOWN AS THE
MASTER PARKING SCHEDULE RESOLUTION TO REMOVE THE
PREFERENTIAL PARKING ZONE ON FIFTH STREET.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department received a petition from 89% of the residents living on Fifth Street from Locust Street to Brockton Avenue requesting the removal of the existing Timed 2-Hour Preferential Parking Zone (“PPZ”) within the segment of Fifth Street; and

WHEREAS, the residents initially petitioned to establish a Timed 2-Hour PPZ due to overflow parking from nearby local residents which was limiting the availability of on-street parking opportunities near their home; and

WHEREAS, the PPZ was established over a year ago and residents indicate that the PPZ is inconvenient, resulting in citations to residents and their guests, and not meeting the overall needs of the residents within this neighborhood and they therefore now desire to remove the zone; and

WHEREAS, the removal of the PPZ will eliminate the current 2-Hour restriction and requirement for residents and their guests to display permits in their vehicles if parked longer than the 2-hour duration on restricted days and times; and

WHEREAS, the residents are aware that longer term and outside source parking may recur as a result of removal of the PPZ and despite those consequences believe that this is the appropriate action for their neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2020, the Transportation Board unanimously approved staff's recommendation to remove the "2-Hour Parking between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday except holidays, with Preferential Parking Permits for residents" zone on the both sides of Fifth Street from Locust Street to Brockton Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That the Master Parking Schedule is hereby amended by removing the existing “2-Hour Parking between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday except holidays, with Preferential Parking Permits for residents” zone on the both sides of Fifth Street from Locust Street to Brockton Avenue.

Section 3: That the provisions of this resolution shall be operative only when signs are erected on that portion of the street set forth in Section 2 above, giving notice of the parking limitations or prohibitions herein established.

Section 4: The provisions of this amendment shall be operative as of the date of adoption of this resolution.
