BACKGROUND

- 1. On November 8, 2016, Measure Z, which is a one-cent transaction and use tax to help pay for critical unfunded City Programs and Services was approved by the City of Riverside voters.
- 2. On June 13, 2023, City Council authorized the allocation of \$6,492,000 in Measure Z funding for Parks capital improvement projects.
- 3. This allocation includes a \$340,000 supplemental appropriation for the Santa Ana River Trail Improvement project.

DISCUSSION

In partnership with the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department, this project proposed to improve the Santa Ana River Trail by

- 1. Installing swing gates and barriers to re-route pedestrian and bicyclists at two locations.
- 2. To provide unimpeded access to emergency vehicles.





DISCUSSION

- 1. On January 18, 2024, the City released Bid No. 8038 for the Santa Ana River Trail Improvement through the City's PlanetBids bidding platform.
- 2. The City's Purchasing Division received seven bids and the lowest responsive bid was 0.75% over the Engineer's Estimate.
