





RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council:

- 1. Adopt a Resolution (Exhibit A) authorizing the application for, and acceptance of, Cannabis Licensing Program funding offered by the State of California Department of Cannabis Control.
- 2. Accept \$475,000 or the actual award amount in grant funds from the California Department of Cannabis Control for the development and implementation of a cannabis retail program in the city of Riverside; and
- 3. With at least five affirmative votes, authorize the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, to record an increase in revenue in the amount \$475,000, or in the amount of the grant award, and record an equal amount in appropriations in the Development Grants Fund, CA Cannabis Retail Access Grant Program; and
- 4. Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all documents for the implementation and expenditure of this grant funds, making minor corrections as necessary.
