SUBJECT: MEASURE Z - AWARD BID NO. 7509 FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY-FIVE CURRENT MODEL FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR SUV PURSUIT VEHICLES TO RACEWAY FORD, RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$830,198.75

ISSUE:

Award Bid No. 7509 for the purchase of twenty-five current model Ford Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit Vehicles to Raceway Ford of Riverside, California, in the amount of \$830,198.75.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council award Bid No. 7509 for the purchase of twenty-five (25) current model Ford Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit Vehicles to Raceway Ford of Riverside, California, in the amount of \$830,198.75 as approved in the Measure Z Spending Plan.

BACKGROUND:

To help address the service cuts as well as a portion of the City's critical unfunded needs, at staff's recommendation, the Mayor and the City Council placed Measure Z on the November 8, 2016 ballot. The measure authorized a one-cent increase in the City's sales tax rate and was approved by over 60% of Riverside voters. The collection of the additional one-cent sales tax authorized by voters through Measure Z began on April 1, 2017.

After hearing recommended Measure Z spending options from City staff and the Budget Engagement Committee (BEC), on May 16, 2017 the City Council approved the Measure Z Spending Plan. As part of the Measure Z Spending Plan, City Council approved funding for a five-year Vehicle Replacement and Maintenance Plan for the Police Department.

DISCUSSION:

On August 21, 2017, the City of Riverside received four proposals in reference to Bid No. 7509 for the purchase of twenty-five (25) current model Ford Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit Vehicles. The lowest responsive bid was Raceway Ford in the amount of \$830,198.75.

The Riverside Police Department would like to award Bid No. 7509 to Raceway Ford for the

purchase of twenty-five current model Ford Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit Vehicles as approved in the Measure Z Spending Plan. The Purchasing Manager concurs that the recommended action is in compliance with Resolution No. 22576.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total fiscal impact of the action is \$830,198.75. Sufficient funds are available in the Measure Z Vehicle Replacement Account No. 3115009-450057.
