SUBJECT: MEASURE Z - AWARD BID NO. 7550 TO STOMMEL, INC. OF ANAHEIM, CALIFORNIA FOR THE PURCHASE OF 25 PANASONIC CF-33 TOUGHBOOKS AND ACCESSORIES - IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,633.44

ISSUE:

Award Bid No. 7550 for the purchase of 25 Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories in the amount of \$125,633.44, to Stommel, Inc. of Anaheim, California.

RECOMMENDATION:

That City Council award Bid No. 7550 for the purchase of 25 Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories in the amount of \$125,633.44, to Stommel, Inc. of Anaheim, California.

BACKGROUND:

To help address the service cuts as well as a portion of the City's critical unfunded needs, at staff's recommendation, the Mayor and the City Council placed Measure Z on the November 8, 2016 ballot. The measure authorized a one-cent increase in the City's sales tax rate and was approved by over 60% of Riverside voters. The collection of the additional one-cent sales tax authorized by voters through Measure Z began on April 1, 2017.

After hearing recommended Measure Z spending options from City staff and the Budget Engagement Committee (BEC), on May 16, 2017 the City Council approved the Measure Z Spending Plan, which appropriated \$9.5 million in FY 2016-2017 and \$20.5 million in FY 2017-2018. As part of the Measure Z Spending Plan, City Council approved funding for a five-year Vehicle Replacement and Maintenance Plan.

DISCUSSION:

On October 3, 2017, the City Council awarded Bid No. 7509 for the purchase of 25 current model Ford Police Interceptor SUV Pursuit Vehicles. In addition to the standard emergency equipment for the 25 police vehicles, these vehicles will need to be equipped with Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks.

On March 9, 2018, the City received three responses to Bid No. 7550 for the purchase of 25 Panasonic CF-33 Toughbooks and accessories. Stommel, Inc. of Anaheim, California, was the lowest bidder in the amount of \$125,633.44.

The Purchasing Manager concurs that the recommended action is in compliance with Purchasing Resolution No. 23256.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total fiscal impact of the action is \$125,633.44. Sufficient funds are available in the Measure Z Vehicle Replacement Account No. 3115009-450057.
