PROPOSAL: The Community and Economic Development Department recommends that the Cultural Heritage Board recommend (1) designation of the Camp Anza Officers Club as a City Landmark; and (2) rezoning to apply the CR - Cultural Resources Overlay Zone to existing R-3-2500 - Multi-Family Residential Zone.


ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The Community and Economic Development Department recommends that the Cultural Heritage Board recommend finding that the proposed project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15308 of the CEQA Guidelines, as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment, said action is intended to preserve the historic character of the building and site, and to provide notice of the historic status.


