SUBJECT: WATER HIGHLIGHTS – January 2018

Domestic water production for the month of January 2018 totaled 3,867 acre-feet (1,260 million gallons), with the following resource mix:

- Bunker Hill Basin: 68%
- Riverside Basin: 32%
- Purchased Water: 0%

Peak water usage for the month of January 2018, was 50 million gallons per day (mgd) and occurred on January 4th.

Under the Cooperative Agreement for Water Production and Conveyance with Western Municipal Water District, 764 AF of potable water and 4 AF of irrigation water were delivered to WMWD.


There were no significant events for the water system in January 2018.
