

Dear Commissioners,

I am concerned about the year-over-year decline in the landscaping and maintenance of the Riverwalk District (including the parks), in which homeowners pay an additional annual assessment, via the Riverwalk Landscaping and Maintenance District fund, to maintain this area "above City standards". Over the past 6 months+, I have submitted numerous photos, via the Riverside 311 app, related to the issues in this area including general maintenance; unkept landscaping, bridges, BBQ grills, and waste receptacles; overgrown trees, unsafe/old fitness and playground apparatuses; graffiti removal; broken water fountains, etc.

Communication from Parks and Recreation representatives consistently respond to this issue as a lack of funding. However, I learned that since fiscal 2014/2015 the Riverwalk LMD budget has had a surplus between \$17k and \$236k, which could have been (re)allocated to address the numerous landscaping and maintenance issues. Please address how the Commission may assist in this matter.
