

Dear Mr. Dunkins,

Your application requesting a vehicle for hire permit was received by Detectives in the Riverside Police Department's Vice Unit on September 21st, 2023. The Vice Unit conducted a background check regarding your application and discovered that you failed to disclose your traffic tickets, arrests and convictions.

The application asked you to disclose and explain any traffic tickets, arrests and convictions you have "EVER" received. You responded by checking the box indicating "NO" and wrote "N/A" in the explanation section for any traffic tickets, arrests and convictions. During this investigation, the following traffic tickets, arrests and convictions were discovered: VC-14601.1(A) Drive while License Suspended-2004. VC-31 Provide False Information to Peace Officer-2004. VC-27315(D)(1) Seatbelt violation-2004 and an additional VC-27315(D)(1) Seatbelt violation-2012.

Section 5.40.180 (D)(4) of the Riverside Municipal Code states that the following:

- (D.) The Chief of Police may deny or revoke the issuance of a driver's permit under any of the following circumstances:
- (4.) The applicant or driver's permit holder has falsified, misrepresented, or omitted pertinent information in the application.

Please be advised that a notice of appeal may be filed with the City of Riverside by depositing said notice with the City Clerk within fifteen (15) days after notice of denial of the application as provided for under section 5.40.185 of the Riverside Municipal Code. The code requires that you set forth in writing the grounds for the appeal.
