2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE GENERAL PLAN 2025 TO REPLACE
4 THE HOUSING ELEMENT, HOUSING ELEMENT TECHNICAL REPORT,
5 AND PUBLIC SAFETY ELEMENTS IN THEIR ENTIRETY, TO ADOPT
6 THE 6TH CYCLE 2021-2029 HOUSING ELEMENT UPDATE OF THE CITY
OF RIVERSIDE TO ADD A SEPARATE STAND ALONE DOCUMENT TO
THE GENERAL PLAN 2025 ENTITLED ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE
POLICIES, AND TO MAKE OTHER MINOR TEXT AMENDMENTS
THROUGHOUT THE GENERAL PLAN 2025 FOR CONSISTENCY
PURPOSES

7 WHEREAS, the California Legislature has determined that the availability of housing is a
8 matter of statewide importance and the cooperation between government and the private sector is
9 critical to attainment of the State's housing goals; and

10 WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 65588(b) requires the City of Riverside
11 ("City") to periodically prepare an update to the Housing Element of its General Plan; and

12 WHEREAS, the General Plan Housing Element serves as a policy and action guide to address
13 the comprehensive housing needs of the City of Riverside; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside prepared the 6th Cycle 2021-2029 Housing Element Update
15 in accordance with California Housing Element Law (Government Code section 65580 et. seq.); and

16 WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 65583 requires that the Housing Element
17 Update contain: (i) an assessment of the City's housing needs and an analysis of the resources and
18 constraints, both governmental and non-governmental, relevant to the meeting of these needs; (ii) an
19 inventory of land suitable and available for residential development and an analysis of the
20 development potential of such sites; (iii) a statement of the community's goals, quantified objectives,
21 and policies relative to the maintenance, preservation, improvement, and development of housing; and
22 (iv) programs that set forth a schedule of actions the local government is undertaking or intends to
23 undertake to implement the policies and achieve the goals and objectives of the Housing Element
24 Update; and

25 WHEREAS, Housing Element Law requires the Housing Element to identify adequate sites to
26 accommodate the City's Regional Housing Needs Allocation ("RHNA") and the City has identified

5 Section 3: The 6th Cycle 2021-2029 Housing Element attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and
6 incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted.


7 Section 4: The Public Safety Element of the General Plan 2025 is hereby amended and
8 replaced in its entirety with Exhibit “B” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, which
9 includes the following entitled documents: Public Safety Element and Public Safety Element
10 Technical Background Report.

11 Section 5: The General Plan 2025 is hereby amended to add a separate stand alone
12 document entitled Environmental Justice Policies, which covers existing Elements within the General
13 Plan and is attached hereto as Exhibit “C” and incorporated herein by reference.

14 Section 6: The General Plan 2025 is hereby amended to make minor text amendments
15 throughout for consistency purposes related to the Housing Element and Public Safety Element, all as
16 shown in Exhibit “D” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

17 Section 7: That an Environmental Impact Report was prepared in connection with this
18 action and has been certified concurrently herewith.
