BACKGROUND

Resource Adequacy (RA) provides sufficient resources and reserves to the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) to ensure safe and reliable operation of the grid.

- May 2006 City Council approved the RA program in response to the CAISO RA Tariff.
- 2. June 2012 City Council approved a revised RA Program. Later that year the City Council also delegated the authority to approve future Annual RA Plans to the Board of Public Utilities.
- 3. August 2020 City Council approved specific revisions in the RA program to eliminate provisions that are no longer applicable and facilitate the ability to acquire less expensive RA resources.

RPU RA PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Prepare an Annual RA Plan.
- 2. The Annual RA Plan must identify capacity resources owned or contracted for that are sufficient for the City to meet at least 90% of the City's System RA Requirement for each month of the coming compliance year.
- 3. Resources must also meet 90% of the Flexible Requirements and 100% of the Local Requirements for each month of the coming compliance year.

CAISO REQUIREMENTS FOR RA PLAN

- 1. **System RA:** Determined based on each utility's California Energy Commission (CEC) coincident adjusted peak load forecasts, plus a planning reserve margin adopted by the Local Regulatory Authority.
- 2. Flexible RA: Derived from an annual CAISO simulation study that evaluates the ramping capacity needed in each month to ensure overall system reliability.
- **3. Local RA:** Determined from an annual CAISO planning study using a 1-in-10 weather year and specified transmission contingency conditions.

RPU'S 2026 ANNUAL RA PLAN





- 1. Includes System RA, Local RA, and Flexible RA requirements to provide efficient and reliable service to Riverside customers.
- 2. Complies with both CAISO and City Council RA Program requirements.
- 3. Maintains fiscal responsibility by avoiding non-compliance penalties and provides lowest possible rates to customers.


