NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, at 3:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter, as the matter may be heard, in the Art Pick Council Chamber, City Hall, 3900 Main Street, Riverside, California, 92522, for the purpose of receiving public comment regarding the California Assembly Bill 2561 (AB 2561) which was approved by Governor Newsom on September 22, 2024, and went into effect as of January 1, 2025. The Assembly Bill requires a public agency to present the status of vacancies and recruitment and retention efforts at a public hearing at least once per fiscal year, prior to the adoption of the new budget, and entitles the recognized employee organizations to present at the hearing.

All persons interested in this matter are hereby invited to appear at the time and place noted above to voice their opinions relating thereto. Persons unable to attend such hearing may forward their written statements relating to the matter to the City Clerk, City Hall, 3900 Main Street, Riverside, California 92522, or email [City\\_Clerk@riversideca.gov](mailto:City_Clerk@riversideca.gov). Comments via the eComment feature at [www.RiversideCa.gov/meeting](http://www.RiversideCa.gov/meeting) may be submitted until 11 a.m. on Tuesday, June 10, 2025.

If you challenge any of the above proposed actions in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk of the City of Riverside at, or prior to, the public hearing.
